NEPAL IMPACT TRIP

In August/September 2024, a group of Trinity College students and staff will embark on a mission to Nepal.

Since the 7.6Mw Earthquake in Nepal in 2015 there has been major devastation to the country and the Government doesn't have the capacity to rebuild and give assistance as other countries do. This will be the first time that Trinity College has had opportunity to go and provide assistance.
